The Buena Brave is the mascot of our youth sports leagues in Buena Vista Township.




### BUENA CHIEFS

### CLOCK TOWER

Symbolizes the construction of the 1979 Buena Vista Township Municipal Building on Route 40 & the clock that was installed for the Millennium in the year 2000.



### SAW MILL AND WORKER

A Saw Mill once stood in this park along with this mighty oak tree helping the railroads grow and to supply building materials to the area.



### KINDEST TOWN IN NJ

Buena Vista received statewide recognition in 2001 for winning this designation with the help of our schools and citizens.

### ROUTE 54/40

The two major highways that cross Buena Vista Township are State Highway 54 and US Route 40, also known as, Harding Highway. Named in 1925 after President Warren G. Harding.



### BUENA VISTA & EAGLE

The Buena Vista Township logo features the symbol of a strong eagle and the words "44 Miles of Opportunity."

#### PADDLES

The lakes, in the Collings Lakes section of the Township were once cranberry bogs and now provide private recreational activities.

### STATE POLICE

The New Jersey State Police is our law enforcement agency that has served Buena Vista since the 1920s. Troop A Headquarters is located on Route 54 and serves southern New Jersey.

One of three different Eagles that appear on this tree. Eagles were spotted during the carving of the Tree Monument and have always symbolized our strength.

### RICHLAND STATION

Buena Vista had multiple railroad stations. The lady in the doorway symbolizes our 1967 Centennial Anniversary celebrating our 100th Birthday, and the fashion of 1867.
